Florence Horn Van Dellen, a long-time community resident, English teacher in the Westfield School system, and long standing member of The Presbyterian Church, died in May, 2002. In her will, Mrs. Van Dellen bequeathed a sum of money to The Presbyterian Church in Westfield to establish a scholarship fund to benefit students who need and are deserving of financial aid for the purpose of obtaining a college education. The Presbyterian Church in Westfield/Clarence H. and Florence Horn Van Dellen Memorial Scholarship was created.

As part of the application package, the applicant must submit:

- the completed and signed application
- an essay
- FAFSA Form for both parents (in a sealed envelope); must be completed online (https://fafsa.ed.gov). The FAFSA is viewed as highly confidential.
- A copy of the applicant's official high school transcript, current class rank, grade point average, and highest SAT scores

The deadline for submission is March 31st. The award is normally presented in June. You will be notified when your application is complete; incomplete Applications will not be considered by the Committee. Completed applications can be returned to the Church Office, attention: Van Dellen Memorial Scholarship.
